

## **COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHT**

#### Sherman's Valley Heritage Days

In 1986, Sherman's Valley Heritage Days was started by local people in the Blain community area as a one-day antique tractor show festival. It picked up after an earlier tractor show had ended several years before, to raise funds for community service organizations. After a few years, it was expanded to three days due to popularity. This year, the 38th Annual Show, will take place October 11th - 13th.

Many activities and events take place during the Show including a large flea market, craft vendors, local and outside food vendors, old-time demonstrators show off their skills, Saturday 9am horseshoe-pitching contest, demonstrations of historic farming skills, parades each day, community food stands and outside food vendors, square dancing on Friday evening, and a community church service at 9am Sunday morning.

The proceeds are used to pay for various services and expenses. Any profits are divided between local community organizations (Blain Senior Center, Comm. Library of Western Perry Country, Blain Ambulance Co., Blain Boy Scout Troop 105, Blain Volunteer Fire Co. and others), and a donation to Make-A-Wish each year.

# MAIN STREET UPDATES

The Perry Hometowns Main Street program (consisting of all nine boroughs) is in its 3rd year in the accredited Keystone Communities Main Street program. The primary goals of the Blain Main Street program are improving the quality of life in a community by making the traditional downtown area, a more attractive place to live, work and play.

The Blain Main Street Committee meets on the 1st Wednesday of each month (7:00 pm) at the Blain Senior/Community Center. We encourage anyone to attend these public meetings to discuss ideas, feedback, concerns, and any questions.

**Current Projects** 

- NEA Grant (National Endowment of the Arts) is in place to have a Mural commissioned on the side of Blain Market that represents Blain. Design under re-work to be finalized in August 2024.
- Prepared Walking Routes for Blain around Wise Farm and through town. Still working on finalizing these routes with landmarks and mileage information. Anyone interested in helping, please attend our March meeting.
- BlainPA.org Website is online and active. In addition to Blain Events, Newsletters, Brochures, a Blain Borough page will be added in the next few months that will allow the Blain Borough Council to provide information.
- Fundraiser We initiated a Fundraiser in October 2023 with a goal of \$1,000 to cover expenses for printing our Welcome to Blain brochure and bi-annual newsletter, and development of our BlainPA.org website.
